The purpose of this EMS protocol is to ensure patients originating from the identified events are assigned to the appropriate receiving hospitals and that the ReddiNet system is used for coordination of patient information.

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OBLIGATIONS OF DESIGNATED BASE HOSPITAL

Riverside University Health System (RUHS) will function as the Designated Base Hospital (DBH) for the above mentioned events. All EMS on-line medical direction and patient destination assignments will be coordinated through the DBH.

1. DBH will staff at minimum (1) REMSA-authorized Mobile Intensive Care Nurse (MICN) assigned and dedicated to the radio room (area) for the duration of the event.
2. DBH will use and maintain the ReddiNet – MCI Function to coordinate and track all patient destination assignments.
3. DBH will contact the EMS Agency Duty Officer at (951) 712-3342 or (951) 712-3467 to:
 - a. Report total number of patients transported from the event every twelve (12) hours.
 - b. Report any unusual occurrence(s) (i.e. actual MCIs, communications failures or other system problems).

The EMS Agency may assign the above functions of the DBH to a different Riverside County Base Hospital in the event DRMC is unable to meet the above obligations for any reason.

OBLIGATIONS OF PREHOSPITAL PROVIDERS

1. The Event MED COMM (if activated) or transporting ambulance paramedic will, prior to transport, contact the DBH for patient destination assignments for all patients.
2. Upon arrival, transporting ambulance personnel will notify the receiving hospital staff when patients originated from an above mentioned event.

OBLIGATIONS OF RECEIVING HOSPITALS

1. All Riverside County receiving hospitals will use and maintain the ReddiNet – MCI Function to coordinate and track patients originating from the above events.
 - a. Hospitals will log patients in the ReddiNet and enter all pertinent patient data.
